Our President’s Letter

Dear Bondurants,

Looking back over the last 13 months we have enjoyed two annual meetings. The meeting in Phoenix in '13 was such a great venue with Bob & Pat Bondurant providing such a fabulous opportunity and were such grand hosts. This year’s meeting in Alexandria was in a very interesting area, with Bondurant heritage in the surrounding states. New members were welcomed and enjoyed at both meetings and a connection to the “Bundrant” spelling has been verified as another branch of the BFA family.

Recently some interesting articles and posts have appeared on the BFA Facebook page, providing Bondurant history in several areas of the country. One letter was found showing that a relative left Virginia and was working in the Victoria Colony of Australia, around the turn of the century. The BFA Facebook page now has 333 members.

Some serious questions have been raised in the recent year about maintaining the health of the BFA. Since Mary Warren Bondurant and her family have been so instrumental in spearheading most of the research and other elements that make the BFA what it is today, the question remains, what can be done to maintain, improve and support the BFA? 2014 ANNUAL MEETING OF THE BONDURANT FAMILY ASSOCIATION

Oct. 17-18, 2014 at Embassy Suites Hotel, Alexandria, VA

This year's "Meet & Greet" on Friday night was attended by 26 family members. Vice President Marcelle Hoffman presided in the absence of our President Ed Bondurant. We introduced ourselves, explained which child we descended from, and heard interesting family stories.

Several members with the **Bundrant** surname attended for the first time, and from them we learned that the spelling variation seems to have taken place about the time of the Civil War.

Jack Bondurant (Andrew Jackson, Jr.) told us that his father A.J., Sr., was born just a few days before the census taker arrived at the family home in 1900. When asked what the baby's name was, the response was "Jesse Minter Bondurant." The family story was that some relative offered the father money to carry on this earlier Bondurant's given name. The young child in 1910 census had the name by which he always was known henceforth, Andrew Jackson Bondurant.

THE 2014 ANNUAL MEETING - Saturday morning, Oct. 18, 2014

The annual meeting on Saturday morning was convened by VP Marcelle Hoffman, with 28 persons present. The reports of the Secretary, Treasurer, and a report on the DNA project followed. The Association has 128 paid members in 2014, and about half of them have elected to receive their newsletters by email, thus reducing the cost of mailing.

Early Bondurant Wives

Our first speaker **John Tyree Bondurant**, a retired attorney from Louisville, KY, brought us the ancestry and family connections among Bondurant wives in the first three generations. *[Editor's Note: His presentation and the supporting documentation will appear in future issues of the BFA newsletter. Thanks for sharing it with all of us!]*

He began with **Sarah Rachael Taylor**, who first married Robert Ligon Moseley. When widowed she married John Bondurant, and thus was the ancestress of many of the attendees. Two generations further back of the Taylor family have been identified through legal records. John also remarked that the Bondurant men seem to have married into Virginia's English gentry, rather than finding brides among

the Huguenots. Their sisters on the other hand married among the Huguenot families of Manakintown, Faure/Ford and Sallee/Salley.

The next wife of note was **Rhoda Agee**, who became the wife of Rev. Thomas Bondurant. Rhoda herself was also a descendant of Jean Pierre, through his daughter Ann and husband James Fauree/Ford.

[Editor's Note: Due to time constraints, John's information on the third wife of note, **Jane Prunty**, wife of Jacob Bondurant, was not covered. The material that our speaker John Tyree Bondurant has compiled on her and her family will be featured in the next issue of the BFA newsletter.]

From Bondurant to Bundrant

Our next speaker, new member **Susan Bundrant Scharf**, brought the history of one branch of the family who became **Bundrants** and left the East for new lands in the west. She covered the family from the colonial period to the late 1800s as they left Virginia and moved gradually across the continent from Virginia to Tennessee, then to Texas. Susan's grandparents continued on to the west coast, and settled in Oregon, her birthplace. With a remarkable collection of family photographs, she was able to show the members of the Bundrant family as they moved and aged.

We welcome **Mrs. Betty L. Thompson Cox** and her family as new members of BFA. Betty has shared her ancestry with us to be included in the BFA database. Her mother **Emma Beatrice Banks** (1907-1975) married **James Thompson** (1904-1949) about 1931. Emma and her four daughters were living with her parents on the 1940 Xenia, Greene Co., OH, census.

Betty's grandmother, **Marie Olla Bondurant**, born Dec. 18, 1884 in Montgomery Co., KY, married **George Henry Banks** 28 Apr 1904 in Mount Sterling, Montgomery Co., KY. They moved to Clinton Co., OH, by 1910 and were in Xenia, Greene Co., OH, for the 1930 and 1940 censuses. George died there in 1963 and Olla in 1951.

Betty's great-grandfather was **James Bondurant**, born about 1845-52 in Montgomery Co., KY, and died in Mount Sterling in Dec. 1936. His first wife (and Betty's ggm) was **Nancy Maupin Hannon**, who he married Dec. 31, 1874 in Mount Sterling, according to the marriage license that Betty sent with her lineage. They had six children before Nancy died about 1906. James married 2nd **Sarah Jane Beane** about 1907 and had two more children.

Saying Farewell to Our Cousins and BFA Members



Carey Woodson "Woody" Randall

October 13, 1931 - October 6, 2014

COLUMBIA - Funeral service for Brig. Gen. Carey Woodson "Woody" Randall, U.S. Air Force (Ret.), 82, will be held at 11:30 a.m. Friday, October 10, 2014, at Northeast Presbyterian Church. Burial with full military honors followed at 1:00 p.m. in Ft. Jackson National Cemetery. The family received friends from 6 until 8:00 p.m. Thursday, October 9, 2014, at Dunbar Funeral Home, Northeast Chapel.

Woody passed way peacefully on Monday, October 6, 2014 at Wildewood Downs surrounded by his family. Born October 13, 1931 in Charlotte, N.C., he was the son of the late Carey Enoch and Ollie Bond Bondurant Randall. He grew up in Columbia and received a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering with communications from the University of S.C. He continued his higher education with a master's degree in marketing from Georgia State. While at USC, he played basketball. He enjoyed golf and played the Hilton Head Heritage Pro-Am fifteen times and was once on the winning team.

Woody met and married his wife, Anne, on July 26, 1957, while working for Southern Bell in the Greenville District Engineering office. As an engineer, he was very successful and had many career advancements. His career in engineering and telecommunications were with Southern Bell, AT&T, Laidlaw Environmental and Bank of America. After a long and successful career in the telecommunications industry, Woody retired from AT&T in June 1985.

Woody continued his service to his country in the Georgia Air National Guard as Deputy Commander at the Savannah Air National Guard Base. Woody is a retired Colonel of the United States Air Force, Air Force Reserve and Georgia Air National Guard Brigadier General. He had a unique tenderness in his leadership style and loved his family and his country. He was a member of Northeast Presbyterian Church and his favorite hobby was golf.

One of the achievements Woody was most proud of was writing and publishing a book entitled "America/Virginia the Beginning, with Family Histories and Genealogies." Woody also served as Chairman of the International Communications Association. He was Chairman and CEO of the Celebrate Freedom Foundation and served in that position until late 2007. He then served as Chairman Emeritus. In addition, he began the "Take a Soldier Home for the Holiday" program. Mayor Bob Coble proclaimed "Woody Randall Day" in 2000 and presented the key to the city to him.

Editor's Notes: The 1956 Louisville, KY, City Directory on Ancestry says her husband was Chester Bundrent. Her SSDI record gives her birth date as 30 Oct 1914. The 1940 Jefferson Co., KY gives Chester Bundrent aged 41, born 1899, and his race as Negro. The 1920 Jefferson Co. KY census lists Chester N. Bundrent, a mulatto, living at 1621 St. Catherine St., Louisville which he owns free & clear, works as a "tinner" with his own shop. His wife Elsiegrey (Elsie Grey) was 17 & their son Harold C. Bundrent was 1½, also listed as mulattoes.

Piccola M. Robinson was born 30 Oct 1914 in Hopkinsville, Christian Co., KY - her mother's name was Addie Merriweather, according to the KY Birth Index 1911-1991 on Ancestry. She is listed as a mulatto, living in the household of her grandmother Sue Robinson in 1920, and a Negro on the 1930 census living with her father F.H. Robinson. She appears as Houston Piccola Robinson, age 25, a Negro, living with her father Frank H. Robinson, and her two sons, Milton Edward Robinson, age 4, & Kenneth Carl Robinson, age 9/12, born IN.
