Mary Bondurant Warren honored with the Augustus Longstreet Hull Award by the Athens Historical Society

The Athens Historical Society presented the A.L. Hull Award to Mary Bondurant Warren at the January 2017 meeting. Followed by a lovely reception, the program consisted of an overview of Mary’s many contributions to preserving the history and genealogy of the Southeast. In addition to serving as a long-time BFA genealogist and newsletter editor, she has published over 200 genealogical titles, and continues to research and create e-books of Colonial Georgia records.

Long-time Bondurant researcher Ruby Talley Smith wrote: “I have a mess that I cannot figure out: There are 2 women named Lucy ALLEN who seemed to have married a George E. BONDURANT on Find-a-Grave.

There is a Lucy (middle name said to be Dillard) ALLEN BONDURANT b. 3/30/1878 d. 6/23/1967 buried in Highland Cem., Danville, VA. There is a stone (Find A Grave Memorial #100121428).

There is a George Edwin BONDURANT b. 12/14/1874, d. 5/27/1945 also in Highland also with a stone (Find A Grave Memorial #100121404). I have thought this George Edwin Bondurant was son of James Saffold BONDURANT and Mary Virginia SLAYDON. I think I still do, but when Mary Virginia SLAYDON

BONDURANT died 3/2/1931 her obit it was said that a surviving son was J.E. BONDURANT of Danville, VA. I guess the initial “J” could have been misunderstood and was really “G”.

Now in Oakwood Cem. in Martinsville, VA there is a stone for Lucy Garnett ALLEN BONDURANT 1880-1935 that shows her husband as George E. “Edd” BONDURANT b. Dec. 1874. There is no stone and I am not sure if he is buried at Oakwood. This Lucy Garnett (ALLEN) BONDURANT is said to have had a sister, Anna Eliza ALLEN b. 5/29/1871, d. 9/18/1940 married James Robert BONDURANT. She is buried in Oakwood and there is a stone. BUT her obit says she had a surviving sister, Mrs. G.E. BONDURANT of Danville. SO her sister must have been Lucy Dillard ALLEN and not Lucy Garnett Allen.

Do you know who was the husband of Lucy Garnett Allen? Are these 2 George Edwin BONDURANTs one and the same and married to 2 Lucys? I have looked on Ancestry.com and the people there are as confused as I have been. I know they have children with the wrong parents and I understand why to some extent.”

Taking this information, I went to Find-A-Grave.com to see what it was showing and I found that indeed it appeared that the linked children of the Obediah Meredith Allen and his wife Elizabeth J. Martin gave their daughter Lucy Allen who did marry George Edwin “Edd” Bondurant as being buried in Oakwood Cemetery in Martinsville, VA. This stone was marked “L. Garnett Bondurant 1880-1925”.

I proceeded to reconstruct Lucy’s family and where they lived to see if we could confirm where she was buried since an obituary for her and her husband Edd aren’t available either on Ancestry.com or GenealogyBank.com. I did locate obituaries for two of her sisters, the oldest Nannie Sue Allen Stults who died in December 1945 that lists one of her surviving sisters is Mrs. G.E. Bondurant of Danville VA. Nannie and her husband Joseph H. Stultz are both buried in the Oakwood Cemetery in Martinsville, where the rest of the Allen family are buried, so naturally when one sees the L. Garnett Bondurant, it would lead one to assume that this is sister Lucy who married Edd Bondurant, except that the obituaries of both her sisters (Nannie and Anna Eliza) clearly state that she resides in Danville, VA.

Lucy’s husband Edd died 5/27/1945 according to his tombstone found in the Highland cemetery in Danville (he’s listed as G. Edwin Bondurant in Find A Grave Memorial #100121404). At the time I was making this search, there existed another listing for George Edwin Bondurant as not having a stone at Oakwood, but it has since been removed. I notified the submitter about the errors and these have all now been corrected – Lucy is now correctly linked with her parents at Oakwood while being buried at Highland along with her husband Edd.

Lucy’s sister Anna Eliza Allen (1871-1940) married James Robert Bondurant, brother to George Edwin Bondurant, both sons of James Saffold and wife Mary Virginia Slaydon Bondurant. Anna and James Robert are buried in Oakwood Cemetery also (Find A Grave Memorials #51868009 and #51867973)

Now to identify the L. Garnett Bondurant, I searched for another death and found several pieces of information to confirm that this grave actually belonged to a male by the name of LOGAN GARNETT

BONDURANT (1880-1935), the only child of John Robert Bondurant and wife Ann Eliza Richardson, who married Julia Verna Harris (1886-1971), also buried in Oakwood Cemetery. Thanks to the censuses which listed him as L. Garnett Bondurant and on his marriage license to Julia he is listed as Logan G. Bondurant. His WWI Registration is indexed as Logan Garner Bondurant, but his signature is clearly Logan Garnett Bondurant with his wife Julia H. Bondurant of Martinsville. The dates on both their stones match up to be this couple buried at Oakwood as they were both from Martinsville. (Find A Grave Memorials 33649092 and 33650175)

JOHN ROBERT BONDURANT (1858-1942) was the son of Robert Garnett Bondurant and wife Mary Ann Jane Davis; and grandson of Robert P. Bondurant and wife Ruth Meredith; and great-grandson of Jacob P. Bondurant and Jane Prunty. Jacob was son of Thomas Bondurant Sr. and wife Rhoda Agee.

JAMES SAFFOLD BONDURANT was the son of Thomas Bondurant and Jane Bonner Neblett; and grandson of Jacob P. Bondurant and wife Jane Prunty. This would make Logan Garnett Bondurant a cousin of both Bondurant men who married the Allen sisters.

As a result of the digging into the Allen family, this is what I was able to put together on these sisters: OBEDIAH MEREDITH ALLEN, born 6/6/1840 in Henry Co., VA, d. 12/21/1926 in Martinsville and buried at Oakwood. He married 1st Eliza Jane Martin, who was b. 10/1/1845 in Henry Co., VA, d. 2/20/1912 in Martinsville and also is buried at Oakwood. She was the daughter of Robert H. Martin and his wife Nancy. Obediah was the son of Jones Allen and wife Susan Minter. Obediah married 2nd 4/2/1914 Mrs. Mary L. Bernard Williamson, b. 9/7/1846 in Virginia, died 8/12/1934 in Bedford Co., VA and also buried at Oakwood Cem.

There were 7 children by his 1st marriage to Eliza Jane Martin:

- 1 - Nannie Allen - b. 1/20/1868 in Henry Co., VA, d. 12/16/1945 in Martinsville, m. in 1896 to Joseph Henry (Joe Henry) Stultz, b. 12/31/1859 in VA, d. 10/6/1935 in Martinsville, both are bur. Oakwood Cem.
- 2 - Sallie Obe Allen - b. 2/17/1869 in Henry Co., VA, d. 1/8/1952 in Henry Co., VA, m. 11/15/1888 in Henry Co., VA to Joseph Thomas "Joe" Hairfield, b. 5/6/1867 in Pittsylvania Co., VA, d. 5/1/1940 in Henry Co., VA, both buried in Mt. Vernon Bapt. Church Cemetery in Axton, Henry Co., VA.
- 3 - Anna Eliza "Annie" Allen - b. 5/29/1871 in Henry Co., VA, d. 9/17/1940 in Roanoke, VA, m. 1/12/1892 in Henry Co., VA to JAMES ROBERT BONDURANT, b. 11/24/1872 in Leatherwood, Henry Co., VA, d. 8/7/1921 in Henry Co., VA, both bur. Oakwood Cem. They had 10 children (that are currently in the BFA database).
- 4 - Fannie F. Allen - b. 9/25/1873 in Henry Co., VA, d. 3/16/1958 in Henry Co., VA, m. ca. 10/16/1927 to James Daniel "Jim" Jones, b. Feb. 1862 in VA, d. after 1940, both bur. Oakwood Cem.
- 5 - son Peachie Leftwich "P.L." Allen - b. 12/20/1875 in Henry Co., VA, d. 2/26/1965 in VA, m. 1/24/1900 in Henry Co., VA to Mary Susan Bell, b. 1/24/1879 in VA, d. 3/11/1966 in VA, both bur. Mt. Vernon Bapt. Church Cem. in Axton, Henry Co., VA.
- 6 - Lucy Dillard Allen (haven't found any actual record giving her a middle name as yet AWS) - b. 3/30/1878 in Henry Co., VA, d. 6/23/1967 in Danville, VA, m. 6/1/1899 in Henry Co., VA to GEORGE EDWIN "EDD" BONDURANT, b. 12/15/1874 in Henry Co., VA, d. 5/27/1945 in Danville, VA; both bur. Highland Cem. in Danville VA. There are 5 known children to this union in our database.
- 7 - Robert Jones Allen - b. 6/29/1885 in Henry Co., VA, d. 2/8/1929 in Martinsville, Henry Co., VA. (His Virginia death certificate gives his birthdate as June 30-his WWI draft registration card that he filled out himself says June 29, 1885.) He m. Nancy Irene Eggleston 3/2/1922, no known issue. She was b. 12/4/1901 and d. 12/7/1994, dau. of George Thomas Eggleston and Ella Frances Fulcher (from Nancy's VA delayed birth record on Ancestry), and m. 2nd George Blake 6/12/1937 in Henry Co., VA.

The second wife of Obediah Allen, Mary L. Bernard (dau. of Silas G. Bernard and Lucinda E. Pullen) was the widow of William F. Williamson by whom she had 9 children according to the 1900 census, in Martinsville, VA. They were married 11/22/1866 in Franklin Co., VA. The 1930 census (South River, Augusta Co., VA) finds Mary living with her son Chapman Williamson and going by Mary L. Williamson, widow. No Allen issue by her.

In confirming the Williamson children, I noticed that several of them were also buried at Oakwood, of particular interest was her oldest, Richard S. Williamson who married Maggie S. Prunty. She was one of the daughters of Robert Prunty and Rebecca S. Neblett. Rebecca was the daughter of William Saffold Neblett and Mary Ann Cheely who are buried in the Neblett Cemetery in Snow Creek section of Franklin Co., VA.

Also of interest is Rebecca's sister, Sarah Elizabeth Neblett (b. 12/18/1834 in Franklin Co., VA, d. in 1908), who m. 3/26/1856 to THOMAS NEBLETT BONDURANT (b. 6/27/1833 in Franklin Co., VA, d. ca. 1908 in Wichita, KS), son of THOMAS BONDURANT and wife Jane Bonner Neblett (dau. of William Neblett and Amy Williams). Thomas was another one of the sons of Jacob P. Bondurant and wife Jane Prunty! Jane Prunty was the daughter of Robert Prunty (b. 1750 VA, d. ca. 1824 in Franklin Co., VA) and wife Frances Sarah Coats. The Robert Prunty who married Rebecca S. Neblett was the son of Jesse Prunty and wife Nancy "Nannie" Finney. In checking family lineages online at Ancestry it would appear that Jesse was a son of the same Robert (b. 1750).

The end results are the Find-A-Grave listings have now been correctly linked to the matching family units and after sending Ruby this information, she replied that Julia Harris is also kin to her Talley family through her grandmother - Julia's mother was Julia Elizabeth Ware, daughter of Nathan Andrew Ware and Martha Cole Talley who lived in Louisa Co., VA (this family can be found listed in the Ware, Waller Cemetery in Louisa Co., VA). Martha Cole was the daughter of George Talley and Sarah Ann "Sally" Cole, who also resided in Louisa Co., VA.
