BFA MEETING WILL BE HELD AT RICHMOND, VA, OCT. 22-23, 1993

Site will be announced in the next newsletter, disclosed Ginny Wray, but we'll again gather on Friday night Oct. 22 to "Meet Your Kin." Saturday Oct. 23, 1993 will include the annual business meeting, a family luncheon, and a program. You'll hear about the dedication of the marker at Genolhac in August, and hopefully there will be some videotape made of the trip.

TRIP TO GENOLHAC IN AUGUST

Led by our co-presidents Ginny and Carroll Wray, the Association will be represented by nearly 30 persons who will be on hand to dedicate a marker commemorating the exodus of our ancestor Jean Pierre Bondurant from France, and his life in the New World.

The marker will be placed on the family home of Jean Pierre, now owned by Mrs. Francois Breton, who has kindly consented to its erection. She will be our guest of honor at a supper prior to the ceremony. Mr. Jean-Pierre Olivier, Mayor of Genolhac, will preside, and a poem written especially for the occasion by Mr. Jean-Pierre Chabral of Paris, will be read to the audience by the poet. Also with us will be Mr. and Mrs. Edouard Goulan-Sigwalt of Paris. Mr. Goulan-Sigwalt has done extensive research on the Bondurant family and its ancestors the Barjons, and Belcastels, which he has generously shared with members of our family.

This will be a moving moment for Jean Pierre's descendants, as we honor his memory, 296 years after he left ancestral surroundings for a strange land. Our group will also be joined by descendants of the Faure and Allegre families, also Huguenot refugees.

HAVE YOU HEARD FROM "MONTINE BONDURANT"?

A recent mass-mailing to persons of the Bondurant surname from "Montine Bondurant" at **Halbert's, Inc., 3687 Ira Rd., Bath, OH 44210** offers us the opportunity to purchase "a remarkable new book about the Bondurants" in which YOU are mentioned. You're also in the telephone directory, from which most of these names are garnered. Don't be fooled; it's not a history of OUR family, although at least they have the immigrant right.

Where did they get the "coat of arms" included with her offering? It doesn't match the one hanging at the National Society Colonial Dames XVII Century Headquarters, which is not necessarily one belonging to our ancestors, either.

NANCY ALICE BONDURANT

Mr. Robert N. Eubanks, 208 Glenn St., Leesburg, FL 34748, has sent his lineage to ZACHRIA TAYLOR BONDURANT and ELIZABETH FRANCIS PYLES, parents of NANCY ALICE (Allie or Nannie) BONDURANT b. 11-30-1873 in Burlington, Boone Co., KY. Nancy m. MARION STEPHEN EUBANKS and lived in OH, IN, and then in FL. Nancy's siblings were Ephrum Downey, d. Augusta, KY; Tyra J., d. Burlington, KY; Andrew d. Washington C.H., Ohio; Stanley R., d. Seaman, OH.

Among the family documents Robert sent was a photograph of Nancy Alice Bondurant Eubanks with her grandson, and three brief documents written in a late 19th century hand.

[This was written on page 32 of a lined ledger. It is apparently the undated text of an obituary.]
Elizabeth Francis Pyles daugh[t]er of Andrew J. and Mary M. Pyles was born in Boone County, Ky. Oct. 30th 1845 and passed away June 23rd 1928 Aged 82 years 7 mo. 23 days.

She was united in marriage to Zachra Taylor Bondurant on Aug. 9th 1865. This union was blessed with five children four boys and one girl all of whom are living.

Mrs. Allie Eubanks of Aurora, Ind.

She was a very patient loving disposition always bowing to God's will in all the trials of life, and looking on the bright side [of life - lined out]

We have lost a loving Mother but feel our loss is her eternal gain. She united with the Methodist Church at Burlington, Ky. in her early girlhood and always lived a life of prayer. Her last conscious words was a prayer for God to bless all....

Mrs. Mary Feagans Stinnett, Route 3 Box 124, Amherst, VA 24521 needs information on her ggf SILAS F. BONDURANT b. ca. 1826, most likely in Virginia. He m. ELIZABETH JANE PATTERSON, daughter of Jane (Jenny) ? and CHARLES C. PATTERSON in Bedford Co., Virginia, on Oct. 2, 1849. Silas had five known children who were:

"Quite a few Bondurant graves are located in Pleasant View Baptist Cemetery, Forest, Bedford Co., VA, were moved to Spring Hill Cemetery, Lynchburg, VA in June 1992. This was done to make room for the widening of US Hwy. 221. All of the identified graves were Silas F. Bondurant's descendants. They included the following:

Fourteen unidentified members of the Bondurant family originally were buried in Pleasant View Baptist Church cemetery, were also reinterred in Spring Hill Cemetery.

The descendants of Charles Henry Bondurant were the only ones that could be located; therefore I would like very much for anyone who has information or questions to contact me. The last known living descendants of Nathaniel Bondurant were ROSE BURR KNIGHT of Lincoln, NE and ELIZABETH BURR (last name unknown) of Scott's Bluff, NE. They are the daughters of ROSA BONDURANT BURR, daughter of Nathaniel Bondurant. Other than Rosa, Claude, Tommie, and Earnest, Nathaniel had a daughter EVA BONDURANT. If any of your readers know the whereabouts of Rose Knight or Elizabeth or any of their descendants, please notify me."

DR. ALEXANDER LEE BONDURANT

Mr. Si Morgan Bondurant, P.O. Box 158, Jackson, MS 39205-0158 sent a photograph of Dr. Alexander Lee Bondurant, whose home "Variety Shade" our group visited in 1990, and a building on the University of Mississippi campus at Oxford named in honor of Dr. Bondurant. "Dr. Bondurant was a former Professor of Latin and Greek and Dean of the Graduate School at Ole Miss, as well as the first football coach at the school. The University of Mississippi is having its centennial celebration of football at Ole Miss this year [1993] and is honoring Dr. Bondurant as the first coach. A history of Dr. Bondurant's original involvement with Ole Miss football is outlined in *OLD MISS REBELS - MISSISSIPPI FOOTBALL*, by William W. Sorrels and Charles Cavagnaro, The Strode Publishers, Inc., Huntsville, AL.

They indicate that Alexander Lee Bondurant was born on June 22, 1865 at Colato [Col Alto] Plantation in Buckingham County, Virginia. Does the Family Association have records that would connect Alexander Lee Bondurant to our immigrant ancestor? [Yes, copy sent to Si was written by Dr. A.L. Bondurant in the 1930s.]

My particular line descends through DARBY BONDURANT, through his second wife, LUCY HALL. "

JOEL BONDURANT

Ms. Gail L. Randle, 22556 Van Court, St. Clair Shores, MI 48081 descends from Joel, a son of JOHN BONDURANT and ELIZABETH DARBY. She also sent a copy of a published Bondurant lineage in which it is stated that JEAN BONDURANT (John, Sr.) d. 1774, m. 1736 Mrs. SARAH RACHEL TAYLOR MOSELEY, b. 1711, who 1st m. Robert Moseley who d. 1734). Bondurant children were Jean, Jr. [John, Jr.] b. 1737; Richard b. 1740, Joel, Rev. Thomas b. ca. 1744; Darby b. 1749.

NICHOLAS PERKINS

The late Mrs. Thelma Willis, of Richmond, VA, sent me a note years ago about 38 Bondurants listed in *DESCENDANTS OF NICHOLAS PERKINS OF VIRGINIA*, by William K. Hall, 1957. One entry shows that our JEAN PIERRE, then called JOHN PETER BONDURANT had a claim against the estate of Nicholas for £1.13.0 for a note dated 3-6-1709, which was presented to Henrico Co. Court 2-6-1710.

Mrs. Willis added that the Perkins family was in Charles City, New Kent, Henrico, Louisa, Cumberland, Augusta, Fluvanna, Albermarle, and Buckingham Cos., VA. [successively?]

MARTHA (Pattie or Patsy) BONDURANT

Ms. Denise Sallee, 935 Forest Ave., Pacific Grove, CA 93950 descends from MARTHA (Pattie or Patsy) BONDURANT, b. ca. 1777 in Buckingham Co., VA. She is believed to be the daughter of THOMAS BONDURANT (b. ca. 1744 VA) and RHODA AGEE (b. ca. 1755 VA). Two sources list their children; one lists both a Pollie and a PAULINE MARSHALL (Polly) BONDURANT b. 1784-85.

Martha m. HENRY SALLE or SALLEE, and moved first to KY, then to MO in the late 1820s. Need records to confirm Martha's parentage, and any other information on her or her family. Henry Salle was b. ca. 1768 in Buckingham Co., VA, and m. Pattie 1793 in VA. Henry and Pattie named four children after Bondurant family members: Rhoda, John, Sarah, and Moses, which seems to support her tie to Rev. Thomas and Rhoda Agee Bondurant.

NORTHERN LOUISIANA BONDURANTS

Ms. Thelma A. Hogan, 5029 Clark St., Baton Rouge, LA 70811 grew up in East Carroll Parish, in the northeastern corner of LA. "There was a rural mail carrier named Bondurant. He was a bachelor and lived in a lovely home built out of brick, over the edge of Lake Providence, with his two unmarried sisters, who I believed to be older than their brother. I am sure they are deceased now, and probably buried in old cemetery of Lake Providence, LA. They were good people.

NATCHEZ CITY CEMETERY

CHARLES BURTON BONDURANT

Mrs. Ruth Ann Bondurant Haller, 7293 Sonora Dr., Rancho Murieta, CA 95683 is the gdau. of CHARLES BURTON BONDURANT of Kalispell, MT, and would like to learn his ancestry.

PETER BONDURANT

Mrs. Gaye B. Robinson, P.O. Box 246, Fancy Gap, VA 24328 is the gdau. of PETER BONDURANT b. 1834 in Henry Co., VA.

MRS. W.E.H. BONDURANT

Ms. Lois M. Scott, 703 Ellsworth Ave., Great Falls, VA 22066 is researching a great aunt ANNA COLLINS, b. 1865, who m. a Bondurant in Memphis, MO. Anna was the dau. of GEORGE S. COLLINS, b. Georgetown, KY in 1831, who settled with his family in the Memphis, MO area before 1859.

An obituary of Thomas Collins, resident of Yakima, WA, stated that he lived with Dr. and Mrs. BONDURANT while attending high school in Downing, MO. She was named as his half-sister. The article also gave her name as Mrs. W.E.H. BONDURANT.

"I have been unable to get much information regarding George and his first wife. I speculate that she may have died leaving only the one child. He then m. MARY L. CARTER who had 2 daughters from a previous marriage. Together George and Mary had 5 sons, one of whom was my grandfather."

FAURE - BONDURANT - CHASTAIN

Mr. Gary Don Ford, Rt. 3 Box 292-A, Terrell, TX 75160 attended school in France the summer of 1986, little knowing it was where his ancestors had lived.

"For years, my cousin and I have tried unsuccessfully to connect our FORD line to the Faure - Bondurant - Chastain line in France, and later in Virginia. We keep getting lost in Tennessee, but continually come across those 'there's got to be a connection' bits of information.

While searching the Faure - Bondurant line on the LDS ancestral files, the name LOCKHART came up. My maternal gggf was ALFRED LOCKHART. He is buried in Coryell Co., TX. His brother was born in Bell Co., TX. The names of these two counties keep cropping up in the BFA Newsletter. Again, I'm wondering whether there is a connection?

Do you have other Fords and/or Lockharts as members of your association?"

DRURY BONDURANT

Mr. Paul Al Bondurant, 5371 Del Rey Dr., Colorado Springs, Co 80918, 719/599-8495 commented on the Bondurant - Tharp marriages in BFA NEWSLETTER 18.

"I have records for my family history back to Drury, but really can not go much further. I would like to get any information you may have on Drury, his relationship to Jean Pierre. I also would like a record of any children attributed to Drury.

My records were compiled by my great uncle REV. HENRY B. BONDURANT. Upon his death, his widow gave the records to me. They consist mostly of letters from the family telling the names of their children, birth dates, marriages, etc. The records were almost complete for the time up to Uncle Henry's death.

Rev. Henry Bondurant had traced the family back to possibly Drury. I say possibly, because he wrote 'According to Mrs. [blank] we are descended from Drury.' According to the history I have and comparing dates it seems to me that Drury would be a third or fourth generation Bondurant in America. I would like to have any information!"

NOAH BONDURANT

Mrs. Margaret E. Jones, 4023 Latham Dr., Haymarket, VA 22069 found her ancestor NOAH BONDURANT listed in the "vital statistics" attributed to Rev. RENE CHASTAIN. Noah was married to MARTHA (Patsy) CHASTAIN Sept. 10, 1807. They lived for a time in the Lexington, KY area. The "vital statistics" had been copied by Miss Sunshine Sweeney from annotations in the back of Guthrie's GRAMMAR.

"Interesting that Miss Sweeney's family home in Kentucky was 'Boscobel.' Boscobel, meaning beautiful tree, was the original Dover of the Huguenots located in Goochland Co., VA. We believe our MARTHA CHASTAIN BONDURANT's mother was MARTHA GUERRANT, wife of RENE CHASTAIN, son of PETER CHASTAIN.

The name Guerrant is mentioned often in these "vital statistics" and is a name connected with both Goochland and Buckingham Counties....

REV. THOMAS BONDURANT, b. 1744-1758 Powhatan Co., VA, d. 1823-1829 Buckingham Co., VA served as a Methodist preacher. Is his church still standing? Where was he buried? Was his mother MRS. SARAH RACHAEL TAYLOR MOSELEY or ELIZABETH DARBY? My husband is descended from Rev. Thomas Bondurant through his son Noah Bondurant, and

Noah's son THOMAS L. BONDURANT. Was Thomas b. Buckingham Co., VA in 1808? Noah had 9 children. We have names of only seven: Thomas L., Mary Ann, Elizabeth, Hercules Agee, Edward Jackson, Noah Simpson, and Samuel. Who were the other two? Would appreciate any information on this family line.

MARY BONDURANT HAMILTON

Ms. Mary Alice Shulman, 2759 Manchester Rd., Ann Arbor, MI 48104-6571 read with interest the piece on PETER BONDURANT, and Harry Green's Bondurant list [both] in Number 11. "My ancestor MARY BONDURANT is apparently either the child of John or of Peter, she having been born ca. 1745.

One thing that struck me immediately when I read old Jean Pierre's will, is that he leaves land to Joseph and to John with the phrase "to him and his arss [heirs] forever," but when it comes to Peter, he says to his heirs "lawfully begotten" forever, which strikes me as clearly implying that young Peter may already have one or more unlawfully begotten heirs. Might this be connected to the fact that his land is later described as abutting that of a mulatto named ANN MOSS, according to Mrs. Warren?

I have a problem with the last part of Harry Green's list. The list from lines 155 through 161 is supposed to be one generation older than 164 through 180, but the birthdays are all in the same decades. Number 180 Thomas cannot be the son of 161 Thomas, as shown, if they were born about three years apart!

Be that as it may, I may have something to add to the final entry since Thomas and his wife PEGGY DRURY are shown as dying in Boone Co., KY. Boon Co. marriage records show the following Bondurant marriages:

- 1820 Sally married PHILLIP BAKER
- 1820 Polly married PRESLEY PEAR
- 1823 Joseph married MARTHA THARP
- 1826 Rebecca married SAM WILSON
- 1828 Drury married JANE THARP.

Thomas Bondurant was bondsman on the girls' marriages.

My Mary Bondurant was the wife of MAURICE HAMILTON, and the mother of MARY HAMILTON who married WILLIAM McGLASSON. The latter Mary was b. 1779 Buckingham Co., VA, according to her obituary.

The first child I have for Maurice and Mary [Hamilton] is Isham G. [Goss?] [Hamilton] born ca. 1763. If this date is about right, it would place Mary Bondurant Hamilton's birth around 1745. The Hamiltons, the William McGlassons, his nephew William McGlasson who married Nancy Hamilton, and perhaps some McNeals, along with their slaves, emigrated together from Buckingham Co. to Boone Co. [KY] about 1812. Thomas Bondurant may well have been part of this group. He seems more the age to be Mary's nephew than her brother.

We can get most of the children of Maurice and Mary Bondurant Hamilton from Campbell Co., KY, WILL BOOK A, page 298, in the February Court 1819, which contains the allotment of the dower of the slaves of Maurice Hamilton, deceased, and the division of the balance of the slaves. This document lists these heirs as:

- the widow [Mary Bondurant Hamilton]
- Henry Hamilton
- John Hamilton
- William McGlasson
- Anthony Garrett
- Jesse Hamilton

William McGlasson, Jr.

Joel Hamilton

J.G. Hamilton [Isham G.?)

We know the two William McGlassons are husbands of Mary and Nancy Hamilton. The daughter who married Garrett may have been named Elizabeth.

The personal tax records of Buckingham County also show a WILLIAM HAMILTON, son of Maurice, but perhaps he died before his father. So Maurice and Mary Bondurant Hamilton apparently had at least 9 children. The only other dates I have are for the birth of Nancy, 15 Dec. 1789, and the death of John, 6 March 1849, and I do not know where I got the latter.

It occurs to me that with that first name, Maurice Hamilton may have had a Huguenot mother, but I have gotten nowhere trying to trace these Hamiltons back. Should any of you have a Hamilton in your early Virginia lines, I would appreciate hearing from you."
