Wish you all could have been with us in Salt Lake, to enjoy the beauty of the surroundings, visit the best genealogical library in the country, and hear the stirring music of the Tabernacle Choir in their Sunday concert. We were even surprised to have a dusting of snow during our visit!

Co-presidents Betty and Wayne Brown presided over "Meet Your Kin" on Friday night, and many of the "regulars" had the pleasure of meeting some of our middle-west and west-coast members. Several persons brought family treasures to share.

A discussion of progress on the American family research brought out many questions and suggestions. Further action was taken during the business session on Saturday.

THE FOUNDING OF OUR ASSOCIATION

Mary Beth Lozo, our founder, was with us and gave a vivid account of the threat to the grave sites in VA, and why descendants gathered on that hot summer day, amid the Poison Ivy, to try to locate the unmarked graves, and stop the desecration. From this effort came the Bondurant Family Association. The effective intervention of attorney Walton Bondurant, Jr., and the late Mary Bondurant Epling, resulted in changing the subdivision road, and saved the graves. Our continued effort surrounded the graves with the fence, installed the memorial plaque, and continues its upkeep.

Carroll and Ginny Wray, later co-presidents, fabricated the memorial, and with the help of the Harry Greens, put it in place within the fenced enclosure. Rev. Wayne Bondurant, a Methodist minister, held the dedicatory service at the site. It was a pleasure to have Wayne and his wife with us at this meeting.

New co-presidents Irv and Ruth Bondurant were elected to serve for the year 1996, and thanks was given to our retiring co-presidents Betty and Wayne Brown.

COMING MEETING SITES

At the business meeting on Saturday, the members present discussed long-range planning for sites of our coming meetings. The Greensboro, NC - Martinsville - Danville, VA area was selected as the site for the Oct. 18-20, 1996 meeting. Hotel and meeting site selection was to be left to our incoming co-presidents Irv and Ruth Bondurant,

and will be published in a later newsletter.

For 1997, the third weekend in October will be the date, and Louisville, KY or its vicinity will be the location. It is our intention to meet in the Williamsburg - Jamestown, VA, area in the year 2000 to celebrate the 300th anniversary of the arrival of Jean Pierre Bondurant from London on Sept. 1st.

INFORMATION ON THE ASSOCIATION TO PROSPECTS

The group acted on the recommendations of two Treasurers, Jack and David W. Bondurant, and voted to use \$500 Association funds to send a direct mail piece to all persons whose surname was Bondurant, or variant spellings. We will also send copies to any persons whose name and address YOU SUBMIT who are not Bondurants, but have Bondurant ancestors. Information on the Association, on Jean Pierre, and the forthcoming American research project, would be included.

The Treasurer will continue to notify members whose dues are delinquent after the first of March 1996.

It was recommended by Betty Brown that a "President's book" be prepared, and transmitted to the newly elected officer, containing copies of all the back issues of the *BFA NEWSLETTER*. Approved.

RESEARCH AND TRIP REPORTS

Mary Beth Lozo gave a report on her research into the ancestry of MRS. SARAH RACHEL TAYLOR MOSELEY, who became the wife of JOHN BONDURANT, SR., son of Jean Pierre.

A report from Mrs. Mary Thomas Dennis, on upkeep of the BENJAMIN BONDURANT CEMETERY was read to the membership.

Betty Brown showed us views of the Huguenot Museum and Memorial, Franschoek, South Africa, which she had visited the previous spring. French refugees, like ours, journeyed to South Africa to escape religious repression, and took wine-making skills with them.

We enjoyed slides taken of the March 1995 visit to France made by Ruby Talley Smith, Charlotte Ballance, Jack and Gretchen Bondurant, Mary B. Warren, with the assistance of Christophe Darpheuil.

WHAT WILL A "CHAIRMAN" DO?

As lineage forms, and information on descendants of "your line" arrive, Mary will send you copies. Your job is to place the data in the appropriate family line, ready to be used for publication. Your effort will shorten the time necessary for us to research our family, so that a true "family history" can be printed in the foreseeable future.

WHAT CAN A MEMBER DO?

Use the NEW lineage and family group forms included in this issue. Make Xerox copies so that you can provide the parents, children and their spouses, for each generation of your BONDURANT ANCESTORS. Their surnames don't have to be Bondurant to be of value to us, for we are collecting data on the Bondurant women's progeny, too.

Mail your completed family lineage, group, and census forms to Mary B. Warren, 170 Windsor Ct., Athens, GA 30606-2956. Be sure your name, address and telephone number appear on each form, in case we need to contact you.

If you know of others, not members of the Association, who may be able to help complete this project with documents, Bible records, or research, please tell us about them, and provide information on how to contact them. We need all the help we can get, and YOUR DATA IS ESSENTIAL! Don't fail us!

GENEALOGY ON THE COMPUTER

While in Salt Lake City for the BFA meeting, Ruby Talley Smith and Mary worked in the Family History Library obtaining various references to the family in books, microfilm, the International Genealogical Index, Ancestral File, and other resources. We purchased a print-out of the Bondurant-Bundrant information and found numerous duplications and discrepancies which we're now checking.

In order to be able to exchange information, most of us are compiling our Bondurant family data using the LDS computer program PERSONAL ANCESTRAL FILE (PAF) which is available for \$35 from: Salt Lake Distribution Center, Customer Service, 1999 West 1700 South, Salt Lake City, UT 84104 1-800/537-5951.

Mary is using a PAF compatible program which will read and write PAF files, but allows greater flexibility in editing and printing. Its forms are those being used in this issue. The program is ANCESTRAL QUEST - \$54.95 from Incline Software, 1-800/825-8864.

POSSIBLE FRENCH TOUR AUGUST 14-24, 1996

The celebration of the Rigordan Road, the old Roman "Tin Road" which ran from Paris area to the Mediterranean near Aigues-Morts will be held in August 1996. M. Olivier, mayor of Genolhac, nominated our ancestor Jean Pierre Bondurant to be the representative for the Department [state] of Gard. The road passed through Genolhac and Chamborigaud, near Jean Pierre's estate Cougoussat. The route of the road will be marked, and cities and towns along the way will participate in "fetes" in August; Genolhac's fete will be held the third weekend of August, 1996.

There will be more information on the celebration at Genolhac, France, in a later newsletter.

If you are interested in taking a tour to France AUGUST 14-24 by bus to visit: Chateau Belcastel (the home of our Belcastel ancestors), Aveyron, Rouergue, the Musee du Désert (a Huguenot historical museum), Aigues-Mort (where Huguenots were imprisoned), Montpellier, and attend the Genolhac celebration, contact Mary Bondurant Warren, 170 Windsor Ct., Athens, GA 30606 before MARCH 1st. Cost, itinerary, and travel plans will be sent to you. A minimum of 25 persons will be necessary to schedule the tour.

ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS TO EARLIER ISSUES

From Wanda Burcham, 4154 - 57th St. North #172, St. Petersburg, FL 33709. In Issue #27, p. 10, the birth date of Rev. Thomas Miles Bondurant's descendant, Sallie is 1788, not 1778 as published, or 1799 as shown in #12, p. 46.

The following might help to answer the query of Mrs. James F. Hitzelberger, Jr. in #26, p. 6. The entry in 1850 Census of Appomattox Co., VA, Household 373, (#12, p. 7). JUDITH BONDURANT (1772-1853) was JUDITH ANN MOSELEY who married WILLIAM BONDURANT (1769-1803) the son of JOSEPH A. BONDURANT and AGNES RADFORD.

MARY A. (BONDURANT) ELLIOTT b. 1801, dau. of William and Judith Bondurant m. ca. 1823 ROBERT WILSON ELLIOTT.

My aunt, IRENE FRANKLIN COLE, a great granddaughter of Sallie B. and John Franklin died July 1, 1995, age 88. Sallie was a great granddaughter of Jean Pierre. I have wondered if there are any other living 7th generation Bondurant descendants, or was Irene the last? [I know of none. MBW]

From Margaret W. Watson, 2101 Rankin Rd., Kiskayuna, NY 12309, 518/374-4933. The last issue of the newsletter was rich in treats for our Bondurant-intrigued minds. I loved it all.

However, some scribe in our past may have had a touch of dyslexia. In the interesting submission re the offspring of Thomas Bondurant and Rhoda Agee, the wife of James Bondurant is listed as Sallie LAWSON. The correct name is SARAH JOSEPHINE (Sallie) WATSON. Reverse the order of the first 3 letters and cross the l, and you get Watson!

John Patterson has done research in the area in which the family lived (near Farmville [VA]) and his records support mine, which are copies from the Bible of James' son JEROME WELLINGTON BONDURANT. Also in *NOTES ON SOUTHSIDE VIRGINIA* by Judge Walter A. Watson, p. 126, see *BULLETIN OF THE VA STATE LIBRARY*, Sept. 1925, we find the will of James Watson who leaves a legacy to the children of his sister Sarah Bondurant. James Bondurant was a witness. On page 131, John Watson, in a fascinating will, also leaves a legacy to his sister Sally Bondurant. (Worth reading!).

THE BONDURANT FAMILY TREE

Family lineage charts as sent in by descendants as of Jan. 6, 1996.

We have received letters in which Jean Pierre was identified as the ancestor, but no line of descent was given; these have been omitted from the following chart. Deceased former member = (dec.).

This issue contains NEW GROUP AND FAMILY TREE FORMS. Even if you have submitted one of our earlier lineage forms, please take the time to resubmit your Bondurant lineage, bringing your family group up to date with marriages, births, and death. Your continuing help will make the job of assembling our FAMILY TREE much easier, and more accurate.

For those, like Sharon Kingen, who have been abstracting census data on Bondurants and their kin, we're also including census abstract forms. Censuses from 1790 - 1840 included only the names of the head of the household, and age groups and sex of all family members. Because we gain so little information from these early censuses, it is useful to assemble the neighborhood where the ancestor lived. On the back of the 1790-1840 abstract form you will see a chart on which to enter the names of the five heads of families enumerated BEFORE and AFTER the ancestor. Frequently these families are the in-laws or "out-laws" of the family of interest.

Beginning with the 1850 census each member of the household was named. The two ## in the left column cover the Household number and Family number provided by the census. After the name of the individual follows the age, sex, color, occupation, state or country of birth, and a remarks column.

In making your abstract place the name of the head of the household at the top of the census, then give state, county, post office, township, or census beat found at the head of the census page.

Remarks are found on the right-hand census page, and include disabilities, attended school within the year, cannot read or write, value of real and personal property, etc.

Rarely a census taker exceeded the requirements and provided the PLACE of birth, an actual town, or county, not just the state. This is a real help, so be sure to transcribe it!

Won't you copy these forms, and send them to me as you complete them, so we can begin working with your information immediately. Thanks for your help!

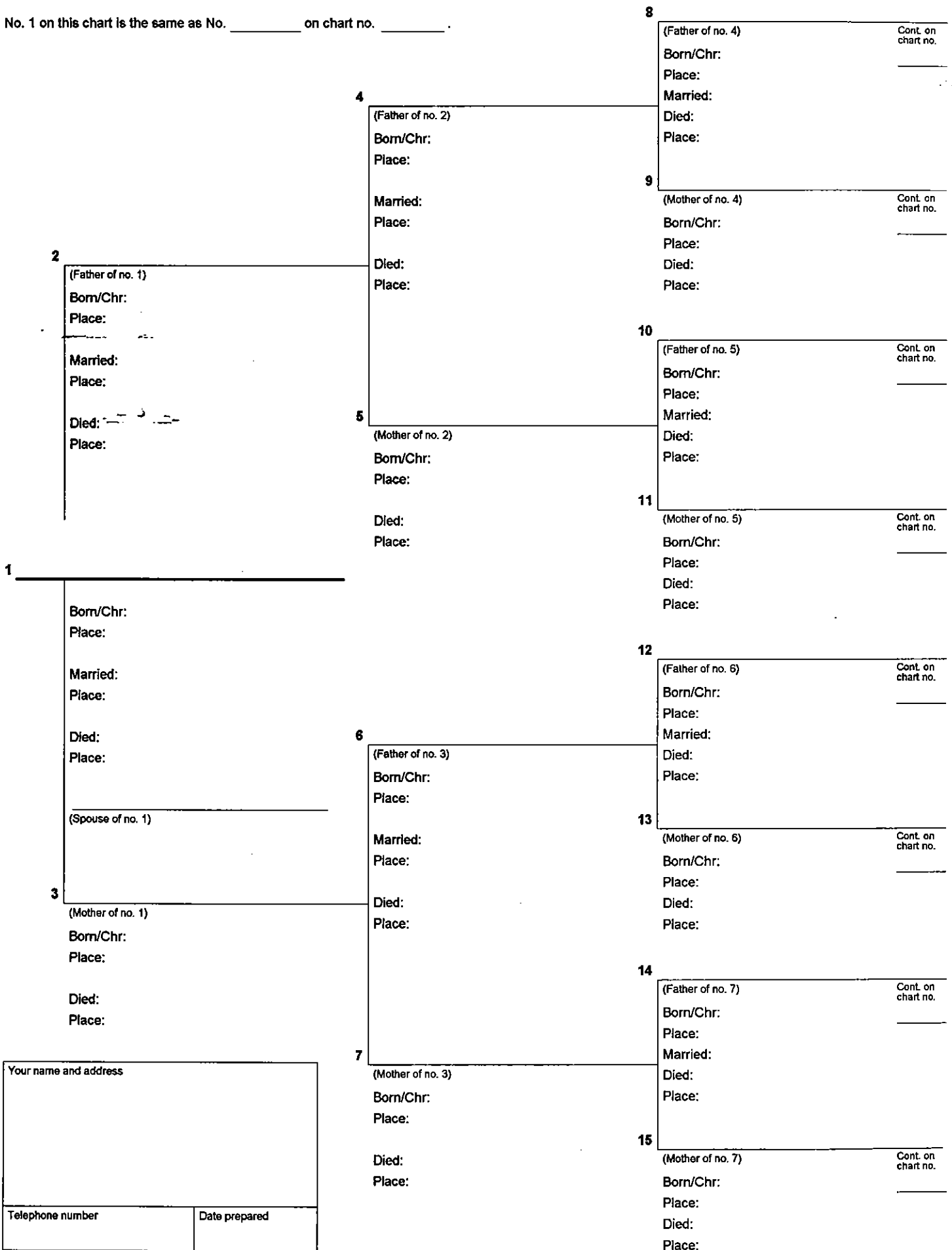
