BONDURANT - GOLDING CONNECTION

Mr. Randolph N. Currie, 5834 N Main St., Sylvania, OH 43560, knew of my interest in the Bondurant family, and sent an extensive family lineage chart of the Golding, Leonard, and Pearson dating back to the 1700s.

"The brothers JOHN RIED GOLDING, and THOMAS WADSWORTH GOLDING were sons of ANTHONY GOLDING (1748-1801) by his 2nd wife ISABELLA RIED. Their oldest sister married DR. ROBERT CAMPBELL, son of ANGUS CAMPBELL and MARTHA LOGAN.

I descend from Anthony Golding's twin sister MARY GOLDING LEONARD COLE (1748 - ca. 1837), and from Angus Campbell on another line.

Mary Golding's son GOLDING LEONARD and his wife NANCY PEARSON, dau. of HENRY PEARSON of Wilkes Co., GA, were the parents of two children who married Bondurants."

They were HENRY GARLAND LEONARD who m. 1838 MARTHA BONDURANT in Marengo Co., AL.

FRANCES ELIZA LEONARD (1814-1857) m. 1828 JOSEPH BONDURANT (1809-1850). They were buried at Magnolia Cemetery, Mobile, AL, and had 8 children.

The third child of Nancy and Golding Leonard was JOHN GOLDING LEONARD b. 1-11-1810, d. 1-11-1840, buried at Magnolia Cemetery, Mobile. No known family.

EDITOR'S NOTE: Miss Edith Bates, 3621 E English, Wichita, KS 67218 wrote in 1989, "I have received some records of a Bondurant family of Virginia and Alabama. Frances Leonard, wife of Joseph Bondurant was my great grandfather's cousin." She sent no further data.

Joseph Bondurant "owned a plantation near Nanafalia, AL, but his home was in Mobile, AL."

I made a note that Joseph's vital records were not confirmed by VA state records. He is said to have been the son of John Bondurant and Martha (Patsy) Walton, one of 15 children!

THE BONDURANT FAMILY (continued from #33)

Mr. Wiley B. Grinnell, Sr., author of *THE BONDURANT FAMILY*, published in 1979, continued his narrative with the lineal descendants of John Bondurant, Sr., whom he refers to as "John Peter Bondurant, the second."

JOHN BONDURANT, SR., [alias John Peter Bondurant, the second], son of Jean Pierre and Ann Bondurant, married MRS. SARAH [RACHEL TAYLOR] MOSELEY in 1729, the widow of ROBERT L. MOSELEY.

"In a 1748 record, John Peter Bondurant was listed as a vestryman in King William Parish. In 1734 John's name was the first mentioned in his father's will.

John Peter and his wife Sarah lived in Goochland County, Virginia, and later in Cumberland County [VA].

On March 9, 1758, he deeded his son JOHN PETER the Third, of Albemarle County, 200 acres of land. After county lines changed, this was in Buckingham Co.

The names of members of the family of John are found frequently in early court and church records. Recorded, also, are many land grants from Royal Governors to the Bondurants.¹⁰

Here began a lineage of Bondurants who became prominent citizens in Buckingham County and today includes many of distinction, scattered all over the United States.

John Peter Bondurant [John, Sr.] and Sarah Rachel Mosel[e]y had four sons. They were:

- I. JOHN PETER, the third [John, Jr.], born in 1737 in Manakin Town. Died in Adairlo County, 1807 [Adair Co., KY?]
- II. RICHARD born in 1740 in Manakin Town
- III. THOMAS MILES born in 1744. Died in Buckingham County in 1829
- IV. DARBY born January 1, 1749, died November 1, 1828.

JOHN PETER BONDURANT III [JOHN BONDURANT, JR.]

Son of John, Sr. and Sarah Rachel Taylor Moseley, and grandson of Jean Pierre and Ann. John, Jr. m. MARTHA ALLEN, daughter of DAVID ALLEN and Martha.

"John III was the forerunner of the Bondurants who went to Bedford County, Virginia, and later to Kentucky in 1781 [yet his son John W. was born in Bedford Co. in 1791]. His family name remained on the tax list there [Bedford Co.?] until 1805. In 1795 Martha, John's wife, relinquished her dower in 200 acres of land which her husband sold.

Bedford County, Virginia, was formed from Lunenburg and Albemarle Counties in 1753. The area is one of natural pine thickets and rolling land with a few little hills.

The only known child of John III and Martha Allen Bondurant was:

JOHN WESLEY BONDURANT born April 4, 1791 in Bedford Co. He married NANCY STIFF, who was born October 10, 1798. Census records show that John Wesley and Nancy (Stiff) Bondurant had eleven children." They were:

¹⁰ The "many" land grants to Bondurants in VA prior to 1750 are only two:

JOHN PETER BONDURANT (Jean Pierre Bondurant), 400 acres of new land in Henrico County, on south side of James River, on Jones' Hole Creek; on Mathew's Branch [also called Oage's or Agee's, after Matthew Agee, whose land adjoined it]. Granted 3-24-1725, at the cost of 40 shillings. This was the land where Jean Pierre lived at the time of his death in 1734-35, which he divided into three parts for his three sons.

JOSEPH TANNER was granted land near this tract in 1730, when Jean Pierre first lived on it, and THOMAS TANNER, JR. was granted land nearby in 1731. There is circumstantial evidence that Jean Pierre's wife Ann might have been a Tanner, for an "Ann Bondurant" the dau. of MRS. MARY TANNER received a legacy in Mary's will.

JOHN BONDURANT, 400 acres in Goochland Co., on both sides of Flatt Creek, a branch of the Slate River, adj. JAMES GATES. Granted 1-12-1747, for £2. This land became successively Albemarle, then Buckingham Co., VA.

LEVENIA BONDURANT

New member Mrs. Virginia Potter Wegenast, 8021 52nd Ave. W, Mukilteo, WA 98275 is a direct descendant of LEVENIA BONDURANT, b. VA, who m. DANIEL H. LONG of PA. Their dau. LUCY LONG was b. 10-4-1827 in Athens, Ohio, d. 7-1-1916 in Palmer, Washington Co., KS. Lucy became the wife of LEWIS HARTLEY (1824-1850), son of JOHN HARTLEY and HARRIET STARKEY.

NANCY BONDURANT, HEIR

Amy Warren Sanders found the estate of CALEB ARTHUR in Clarke Co., GA, 1845 showed one NANCY BONDURANT as one of his heirs.

JOHN PETER BONDURANT - VA AND KY

Found in the *AMERICAN LOYALISTS CLAIMS*, filmed as part of the British Manuscripts Project by the Library of Congress, was a list of claims made during 1784-1803 against citizens who formerly resided in VA, but had moved to KY. [Public Record Office 122, vol. VI, No. 79, reel 041]

Page 96. HENDERSON McCALL & CO. vs. JOHN P. BONDURANT[s] CUMBERLAND STORE. Debt £1.2.8. "Removed to Kentucky, Madisen County, able to pay. Proved by WM. BONDURANT"

ADAIR COUNTY, KY, STRAY BOOK #1

KENTUCKY ANCESTORS, vol. 7 #1, 1971 included abstracts made by Mrs. Ruth P. Burdette, which she wrote "has been lots of help to me in locating various people. It lists men who have picked up stray animals which they thus advertise so the owners may claim their property. Usually the water course on which the person lives is given."

One of the persons in 1802 who took in stray stock was JOHN BONDURANT [sic], of Green River, who tolled the animal before JAMES GILMER, J.P.

Also finding stock on Green River was GEORGE DAMRON. JOHN PETER BONDURANT of VA and KY married the widow Susan or Susannah Damron as his last wife. John Peter died testate in Adair Co., KY 1807, dividing his estate between his surviving son William Bondurant, and her son Samuel Damron. Witnesses were Robert T., George W., and John T. Damron.

The 1807 Will of JAMES THOMAS of Adair Co. named his wife Ann, and children Hardin, Robert, John Thomas, SUSANNEY BUNDREN [John Peter's wife], LUCY SWEENEY, NANCY HELLEMS, and also SARAH WINFREY who was not specifically called James' child.

Susannah married 3rd CAMPBELL GOODE of Adair Co., KY, who in an affidavit dated 10-26-1819, relinquished his right to the estate of John P. Bondurant, "by virtue of my marriage with Suzanna Bondurant, widow of the said decedent to the heirs and legal representatives of GEORGE DAMRON deceased...."

July 17, 1780, Albemarle Co., JOHN PETER BONDURANT [later of KY, above], 1125 acres among the head branches of Sharp's Creek, patent A, 1779-80, p. 682 [now Buckingham Co.]

Aug. 14, 1792, Buckingham Co., DERBE [DARBY] BONDURANT, 290 acres on the south branch of Sharp's Creek, grant #26, 1792, p. 723

Feb. 12, 1802, Buckingham Co., DAVID BONDURANT, 21 acres adjoining ANN MOSS, JOHN B. COUCH and TAPSCOTT lands, grant #48, 1801-2, p. 377

May 1, 1857, Franklin Co., JAMES R. BONDURANT, 97 acres on waters of Snow Creek, grant #113, p. 601.

Mr. Thomas Jouett Marshall, Jr., of Paducah, KY, donated a photocopy of this Bible to the Filson Club, Louisville, KY in 1971. Publisher and Bible date was not given.

This certifies that the rite of Holy Matrimony was celebrated between Thos. J. Juett [sic] of Greenupsburg, Ky. and Emily Kouns of Cabel Co. [Cabell Co., now WV], Va. on March 19th 1835, at Cabel Co., Va. by Rev. Miller.

A.L. Bondurant received an A.B. degree from Hampden-Sidney in 1884, was a member of Kappa Sigma fraternity, Phi Kappa Phi, and Sigma Upsilon. Received an A.M. in 1892; taught at University of Texas 1886-87; University of Virginia 1887-89; Harvard 1892-93, receiving an A.M. in 1893; studied in Berlin, Munich, Rome; received LL.D. from Mississippi College in 1921.

Was Assistant and Associate Professor at University of Miss. from 1889-1895, and professor of Latin from 1895. He served with the Y.M.C.A. in France during World War I, 1918-1919, as director of the 2nd Combat Area, later was dean of American Students at University of Dijon [France]. See WHO'S WHO IN AMERICA. Residence: University, Mississippi.

p. 154, JOSEPH BONDURANT and FRANCES LEONARD licensed to marry June 17, 1828, executed June 21st by Henry Chiles, J.P., George Cunningham, security. [mentioned earlier in this issue]

p. 172, JOHN RAINS and MARTHA JANE BONDURANT, licensed Oct. 1, 1828, executed Oct. 2 by Thomas Davis, M.G. [minister of the gospel], Charles Irby, security.

OWEN'S DICTIONARY OF ALABAMA, vol. 4, p. 1405 says John Rains died ca. 1839-41 in Marengo Co., AL. Among children: JOHN BONDURANT RAINS b. June 23, 1830. John Rains was son of Gabriel M. Rains and Esther Ambrose. Martha Jane Bondurant was of CUMBERLAND CO., VA.

p. 178, H.M. BONDURANT [male] and E.A. WILLIAMS, licensed Nov. 27, 1828, executed Dec. 4th by Thomas S. Abernathy, John Rains, security.
