Margaret was the child of MARION LEE BONDURANT, b. 9-30-1863 Scotland Co., MO, d. 5-9-1948 at Kirksville, MO, and MARGARET HULDA NORTON b. 2-27-1869 Scotland Co., d. 1-10-1946, Fulton, MO, who m. 3-23-1886 in Scotland Co.

Marion was the son of DAVID GARRETT BONDURANT b. 5-22-1817 Buckingham Co., VA, d. 1-7-1873 Scotland Co., MO, and ALMIRA HOPE b. 12-30-1820 KY, d. 8-18-1888 in Scotland Co., who m. KY 10-24-1850.

David G.'s parents were DAVID BONDURANT b. 5-25-1775, and POLLY GARRETT, daughter of CHARLES GARRETT and CLOE AGEE.

David was the son of DARBY BONDURANT b. 1-7-1749, d. 1921, who m. 1821 RUTH AGEE b. 1753, d. 1780.

Mrs. Junkin's youngest sister AUDREY BONDURANT WOODS survived her, aged 90. Thanks to her nephew, Rev. Wayne BonDurant, for this information.

VIRGINIA RESOURCES

THE VIRGINIA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY NEWSLETTER has been our source of recent donations relating to the Bondurant family.

From October 1996 issue: The Jones Memorial Library, 2311 Memorial Ave., Lynchburg, VA 24501, has prepared an index to obituaries appearing in the Lynchburg-area newspapers in their collection. This index covers the following years 1837-1865 (typed); 1866-1885 (file cards); 1892-1897 (computer printout); 1974-1990 (file cards); 1991-1996 (computer printouts).

"The card files for the 1974-1990 period are divided between the City of Lynchburg, and the Lynchburg-area, including Amherst, Bedford, Campbell and Nelson Counties....

Only those items giving some family or genealogical information have been indexed. Death notices giving only the fact that a person had died, news stories recounting the events that might surround a death, and coverage of the death of someone with no family or physical connection to the Lynchburg area are generally not indexed.

The information appearing in an index entry is limited to the name of the deceased and the reference for the date, page, and column number [of the newspaper] where the full obituary can be found."

Omitting those without genealogical information will make this index much less useful, but potentially the decedents could be located in Vital Records' death certificates for modern times.

From April 1997 issue: Recent donation to the Virginia Historical Society, 428 N Boulevard, Richmond, VA, is a Bondurant Bible record. No other details were shown, but among unpublished genealogical notes also accessed by the VHS were those of the TURPIN family who were intimately involved with the Bondurants during the first half-century in Virginia.

From June 1997 issue: Virginia Archives, 800 East Broad St., Richmond, VA accessioned 18 pages, photocopies of notes on the descendants of NOAH BONDURANT (1784-1856) of Buckingham Co., VA, and later KY and IN. Accession #35087.

From August 1997 issue: Virginia Archives (address above), 5 pages of photocopies on the TURPIN family of Chesterfield Co. and Richmond, VA, 1748-1919. Other surnames mentioned: CLAY,

GREGORY, JOHNSON, KING, LEE, MANN, TRABUE [who intermarried with the Bondurants], and WILLIAMS. Accession #35085.

NATHANIEL MAXEY AND TEMPERANCE EMBRY

Mrs. Margaret Ann Burroughs Aull (Mrs. George F. Aull), Peggy, and Ms. Carole Stowell, share these common ancestors, who connect to the Bondurant family, they have written.

ANOTHER BONDURANT DESCENDANT

Mrs. Barbara J. McCoin, 312 Seven Oaks Trail, Knoxville, TN 37922, 423/539-0426, inserted a query in the Bradley Co., TN, Genealogical Society publication in August 1997. She descended from BRASHEAR, FAURE, WITT, SEVIER, DAVID, LAMAR, AMIS, NAPIER, EASLEY, CHASTAIN, RUCKER, CROCKETT, and FOUSHEE families in addition to Bondurant. "All of these are French Huguenots, and there are many more. Many came to East Tennessee.

JOHN BONDURANT - LUCY GILLEY DESCENDANT

Mrs. Frances Willess, 1011 Karen Ave., Austin, TX 78757, 512/458-3903, is working on her husband's ancestors. John "Bundrant" was born 6-22-1782 VA, and died 6-30-1850 in Lawrence Co., TN. In 1816 in Henry Co., VA, he married LUCY GILLEY. An old family story says he was the son of THOMAS BUNDRANT and SARAH MACKA, but proof is lacking.

"While visiting in Vienna, IL, last fall researching my HARVICK family, I found a book on the Bundren family. It turned out the librarian is a member of that family, and believes they are descended from CLAIBORNE BONDURANT, who moved to AL. Her cousin was in the process of updating the book at that time. The one I met was Margaret Mathis, 1590 Dutchman Lake Rd., Vienna, IL 62995. She is librarian in the Carnegie Library there [Vienna, IL]."

Mrs. Willess also sent a copy of the British Mercantile Claims abstracts which appeared serially in *THE VIRGINIA GENEALOGIST*.

T 79/81 [Treasury records]

The claim of ALEXANDER SPIERS, JOHN BOWMAN & CO., page 135:

[Debtor] JOHN BONDURANT £17.8.11¼, [owed to the] Manchester Store. Suit is brought in Buckingham [Co.] Court and the defendant is able to pay it.

Claim of HENDERSON McCALL & CO., page 96:

JOHN P. BONDURANT [John Peter], £1.2.8, Cumberland [Co.] Store. Removed to Madison Co., KY, able to pay.

RICHARD BONDURANT £25.7.1½, and £6.17.11½, Richmond Store. Removed to Henry Co., VA, and insolvent in 1783.

Mrs. Catherine R.M. Trent, P.O. Box 418, York Harbor, ME 03911, 207/363-4987, came from "cyberspace" with this question on her husband's ancestors Sarah and Thomas, who m. 10-8-1857, possibly in Bedford or Campbell Co., VA.

"I cannot find her [Sarah's] line of Bondurants. I have found a JASPER BONDURANT married to a Martha or Matilda, who might be her father, but cannot confirm." Need parentage of both Sarah and Thomas.

Who were the parents of Sally Bondurant, and when was she born? She married Abraham Carter 4-22-1821 in Patrick Co., VA. Any information on her would be appreciated!

EDITOR'S NOTE: Sorry we can't help, Jane, for all we have is the couple and their marriage date. Does the marriage license or bond include a "consent" of Jane's parent or guardian? It would, if she were underage. I don't find that there was a Bondurant head of household living in 1820 in Patrick Co., VA. Might this family have moved in shortly before Sally married Abraham?

THE OLD DOMINION WHO'S WHO, VIRGINIA LIVES

Two Bondurant kinsmen were included in this biographical directory:

JOHN CLARK BONDURANT, banker, 504 First Ave., Farmville, VA. Born 9-14-1897 in Rice, Prince Edward Co., VA, the son of **EDWARD TAYLOR BONDURANT** and **AGNES LEIGH CLARK**, "and is of French ancestry."

John married **MOLLY CATHERINE MOORE**, a native of Farmville, 6-5-1926. Their two children were **BETTY CLARK BONDURANT** deceased before 1964, and **CATHERINE TAYLOR BONDURANT**, wife of **JAMES H. CARPENTER**.

Mr. Bondurant served in World War I, as private in U.S. Army. He is a Methodist.

WALTER MARION BONDURANT, SR., merchant, "Monte Vista", Collinsville, VA. Born 11-10-1915, Alderson, Greenbrier Co., WV, the son of **WALTER EMMETT BONDURANT** and **BESS CRAWFORD**, "and is of French Huguenot ancestry."

Walter was educated at Alderson Junior College, Phillipi, WV, and National Business College, and was a Methodist. On 5-15-1940 he married **DORIS BERRY** of Bassett, VA. Their children: Walter Marion Bondurant, Jr., and Dickey Crawford Bondurant.

MARY BONDURANT AND MAURICE HAMILTON

Another Internet family query came from Mr. Jeff Duvall, 920 E Markwood Ave., Apt. A10, Indianapolis, IN 46227, e-mail: jduvall@indyvax.iupui.edu. Jeff is a doctoral student in history at Purdue University.

Maurice Hamilton (ca. 1745 - 1819) married Mary Bondurant ca. 1764-65, and they appeared in records of Buckingham Co., VA, from ca. 1773 to ca. 1810, when they moved westward to Campbell Co., KY. They were the parents of 10 children.

Need a linkage from them to **MAURICE HAMILTON** (ca. 1797-1861) of Campbell and Gallatin Cos.,

KY, who may have been their grandson. Other information suggests that the younger Maurice was the son of JOHN HAMILTON and his wife Jane, who may have been the daughter of SAMUEL HAMILTON, uncle of John.

"Can you tell me if you have any further information on --

(A) this Hamilton family

(B) the ancestry of [Mrs.] Mary Bondurant Hamilton, and

(C) whether or not she might be a daughter of PETER BONDURANT, son of JEAN-PIERRE BONDURANT" and his wife Ann.

"I am very eager to sort this all out because I have been told for years that my great great great grandmother LAVINIA HAMILTON BALES (1833-1911) of Gallatin and Owen Cos., KY, took great pride [in] her French ancestry and heritage and that it came to her through her father's side of the family...."

Children of Maurice Hamilton (ca. 1797-1861) and his wife ELIZABETH ELLIS (1799-1855) who m. 10-24-1816 in Campbell Co., KY, were: Nancy, Joel, Washington, William, Lavinia wife of Mr. BALES, Maurice (Morris), Henry Clay, Josephine, and Oliver.

"There may have been additional children but these are the only names that I have. Once again any and all help will be much appreciated."

EDITOR'S NOTE: Ms. Mary Alice Shulman, 2759 Manchester Rd., Ann Arbor, MI 48104-6571 (in 1993) also descended from this couple. In a letter that year she disclosed "we can get most of the children of Maurice and Mary (Bondurant) Hamilton from Campbell Co., KY, Will Book A, page 298, in the February Court 1819 which contains the allotment of the dower in the slaves of Maurice Hamilton, deceased, [to the widow], and the division of the balance of the slaves.

This document lists these heirs as: the widow; Henry Hamilton; John Hamilton; William McGlasson, Anthony Garrett, Jesse Hamilton, William McGlasson, Jr., Joel, and Isham G. Hamilton.

We know the two William McGlassons are the husbands of Mary and Nancy Hamilton. The daughter who married [Anthony] Garrett may have been named Elizabeth.

The personal tax records of Buckingham Co. also show a William Hamilton, son of Maurice, but perhaps he died before his father. So apparently Maurice and Mary (Bondurant) Hamilton had at least nine children. The only other dates I have are for the birth of Nancy, 15 Dec. 1789, and the death of John, 6 March 1849, and I do not know where I got the latter," added Ms. Shulman.
