EDOUARD GOULON SIGWALT

On April 10, 1998 the Bondurant Family Association lost a staunch friend when M. Edouard Goulon Sigwalt died in Paris.

As a gift to his nephew and god-son Robert Edouard Bondurant, M. Goulon Sigwalt began to research Robert's French ancestors, the Bondurants. It was M. Goulon Sigwalt who disproved much of the published writings on our French origins, and he who documented our family back to Genolhac, Gard, France.

Over the years M. Goulon Sigwalt, assisted by his sister Mrs. Marielle Bondurant who translated the letters into English, shared the genealogy of our family with the American Bondurants.

With his help we made contacts in Genolhac which resulted in the dedication of the plaque to Jean-Pierre Bondurant, the immigrant, there in 1993. Through his efforts we now know who we are, and where we came from.

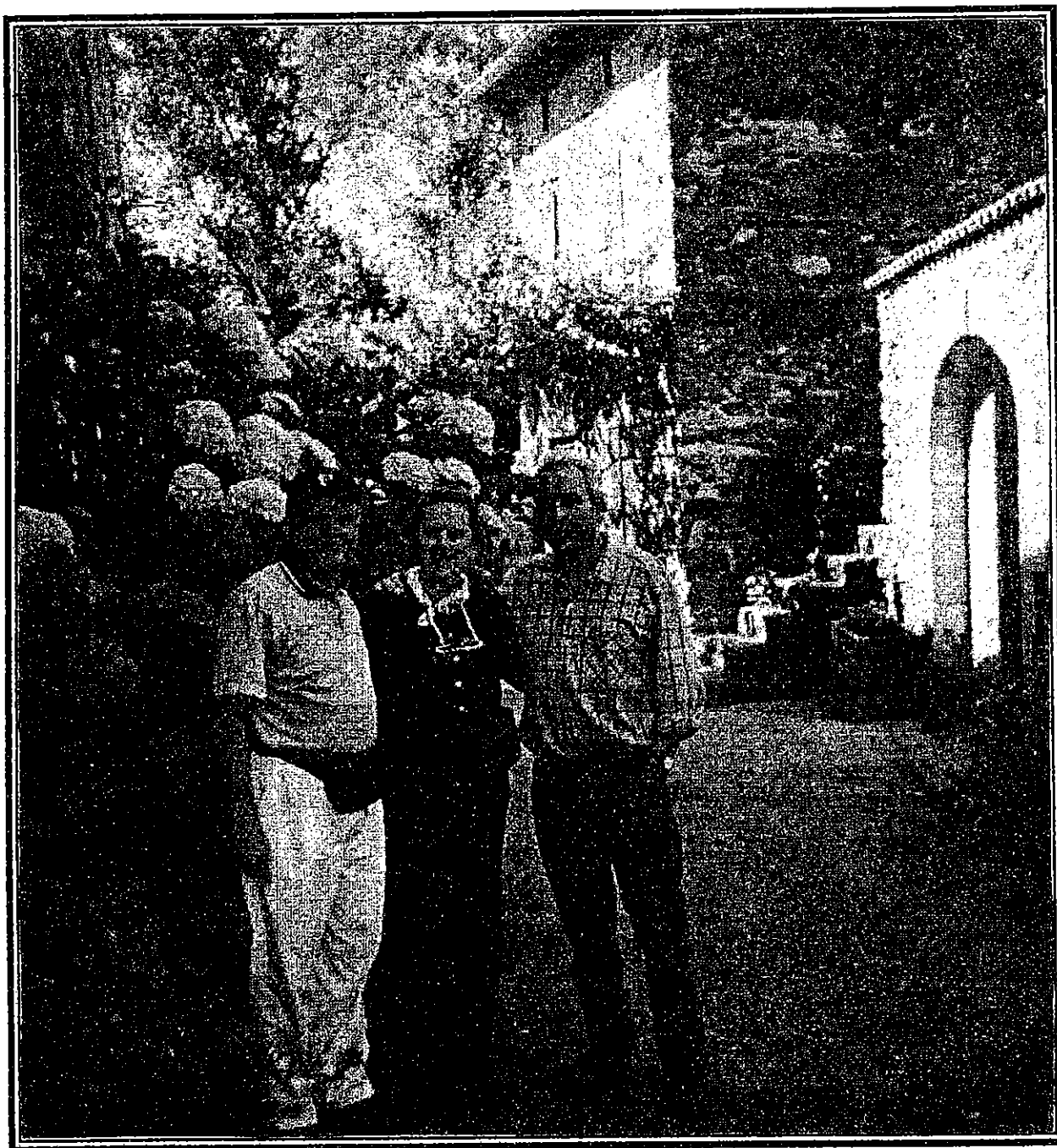

FRENCH BONDURAND GRAVES BEING MARKED

In June 1997, accompanied by Gregor and Marianne Bawidamann, my tri-lingual Swiss friends, Jim Bondurant and I stopped by Belle Poile, France, near Genolhac. Here we found Claude and Danielle Bondurant opening up their "summer home," an old Bondurant inn.

We were photographed standing in the "Régordane Road" (the old "Tin Road"), used since Roman times to haul minerals and produce from le Puy en Velay south to Aigues-Mortes, a port on the Mediterranean. On the right in the background is the Bondurant home; on the left were storage buildings where chestnuts, the major produce of the region, were dried before being made into flour.

Further up the hill on the left lay the Bondurant family cemetery, with only two wooden markers surviving. On a previous trip Claude had told us about this cemetery, which we photographed. We had discussed with him the identities of those in unmarked graves. Today he proudly showed us the new gravestones he had ordered to mark their resting places.

Here are their inscriptions (with family relationships in parentheses).

FRÉDÉRIC BONDURAND, 1848 - 1925

ALBINA BONDURAND neé POLGE, 1850-1931

(These were Claude's great grandparents, parents of Alfred Bondurant.)

BLANCHE FOSSAT neé BONDURAND, 1889 - 1919

(Daughter of Frederic and Albina.)

ALFRED BONDURAND, 1876-1937

ANAIS BONDURANT neé VEYRAS, 1879-1937

(Claude's grandparents. Alfred and Anais had three sons: Charles, Roger, Claude's father, and André Bondurant. Roger and André still live in Genolhac. André has two daughters, and Claude is an only child and has no children. Thus the Bondurant surname dies out with their generation.)

CHARLES BONDURAND, 1908-1948

(He never married.)

RAYMONDE BONDURAND neé VILLAIN, 1910-1996.

(Wife of Roger, and Claude's mother. Neé = born; her maiden name was Raymonde Villain.)

Nearby are the ruins of the Bondurant's original home at Malilhères. Our ancestor Antoine Bondurant left in the late 1400s for Genolhac where he became a hotel keeper. One might speculate that Antoine's family home at Malilhères had also welcomed travelers along the Régordane Road, only a few steps away. Genolhac hotel keepers ran in the family for at least 5 generations.

Down the steep hill is Donarel, home of the Amat family (formerly of Vielvic). Their home stands near the headwaters of the le Luech River. In 1558 Antoine's grandson Antoine II married GILLETTE AMADE (the feminine form of her surname); he died 1604 in Genolhac and was yet another hotel keeper.

CORRECTION FROM MARK BONDURANT

of 440 Oak Ridge Road, Tuckasegee, NC 28783. After meeting his wife Darcia in January, we included them in issue 37. Mark clarifies his Bondurant ancestry in a later letter.

"I am the son of Gladys and William Warren Bondurant, It's my dad's mother who is Nan; her husband was Herbert Lee Bondurant. My grandfather died a year before I was born. My father died in 1989, but my grandmother Nan Bondurant is 92 years old and lives in Charlotte, NC. My younger brother's name is William Scott Bondurant.

I don't know of what interest other family members would be to you and your readers, so I'll stop there...."

WORLD FAMILY TREE'S BONDURANT FILES

Thanks to Jim Mehaffey (e-mail: jmehaf2028@aol.com) who sent two files from World Family Tree, of which he is a member. One file concerned the Bondurant family in France, for whom we already have information. Unfortunately, World Family Tree has continued some of the errors published many years ago in *THE HUGUENOT*.

It did, however, fill in the names of siblings of Jean-Pierre who died in infancy. Dates of birth must have come from the Protestant and Catholic Church record in the Mairie at Genolhac, where the baptism of Jean-Pierre can be found.

Father was Jean-Pierre Bondurant, Sieur of Cougoussac (a large property on the le Luech River south of Genolhac), son of Dr. Pierre Bondurant of Genolhac. Jean-Pierre (Sr.) was born ca. 1646 probably in Genolhac, and died 23 May 1694 probably at Genolhac, Gard, France.

At Barre de Cevennes, Lozere, France, he was married to Gabrielle Barjon, 28 Oct. 1676, by her brother Pastor Guillaume Barjon, the Huguenot Church minister there.

According to World Family Tree, the children of Jean-Pierre and Gabrielle, and birth order is as follows:

1. JEAN-PIERRE, our ancestor, b. 18 July 1677, Genolhac, Gard, France, d. ca. 1734 Manakintown, Goochland (not Henrico) Co., VA.
2. André, b. ca. 1681.

5. Françoise b. ca. 1688 (the only other child who lived past infancy).

8. Louise b. 29 May 1693.

Sieur Jean-Pierre Bondurant died only a year after Louise's birth, and Gabrielle soon afterward in March 1695. How long each baby lived after baptism could be learned from the record of sepulchures of the Catholic priest in Genolhac, for the family became "newly converted Catholics" following the Revocation of the Edict of Nantes in 1685.

Now let's skip down to the "family" assembled by World Family Tree for the Bedford Co., VA, Bondurants. Progenitor is said to be John Pierre Bondurant III, grandson of the immigrant Jean-Pierre and Ann, and son of "John Peter Bondurant II" and "Sarah Taylor" [Mrs. Sarah Rachel Taylor Moseley]. The Bedford progenitor is said to be the son John [not Pierre] baptised in King William Parish, Goochland [not Henrico] Co., VA. and an unknown wife whom he married ca. 1759 in VA.

Daniel Maxey Bondurant's tombstone in Natchez City Cemetery, MS, said he was born 14 Feb. 1779 in Bedford Co., VA, and d. 20 March 1837 in Adams Co., MS, aged 58 years, 1 month, and 6 days. Daniel was in the tax lists of Bedford Co. from 1801 through 1806, then vanished. Perhaps he went to the Mississippi Territory at that time.

Although Bedford Co. was created in 1753 from Lunenburg Co., I haven't found records of Bondurants there until the late 1780s. Daniel Maxey Bondurant's parentage has long been a mystery. One wonders just how this "family" was assembled. Are there unknown (to us) legal records which tie them together?

Now let's follow World Family Tree as it unravels the family of Littleberry Bondurant and Mary Scott, who married 8 Sept. 1790 in Liberty [not Bedford], Bedford Co., VA.

Their only child named was James Scott Bondurant, born 19 April 1803, Bedford Co., and d. 19 Nov. 1880 in Bedford Co., VA.

James Scott married twice. First to Celia [not Celina] Davenport, 22 Dec. 1824, in Bedford Co., the daughter of William Davenport. James Scott and Celia are buried in Longwood Cemetery, Bedford, VA, with a common headstone.

James Scott's 2nd wife was said to have been his cousin, Elizabeth (Bettie) Snead, daughter of Gabriel Snead and Sophia Smith. James and Bettie married 6 Jan. 1865 in Bedford Co. Bettie was born between 1827-38 in VA.

6. James Walker, b. 28 Aug. 1845 Bedford Co., VA, d. 2 Oct. 1922. Wife and any children are unknown.
7. Emma, b. 20 May 1851 Bedford Co., VA, d. 16 Dec. 1934 Roanoke, VA. She m. 13 June 1868 in the Methodist Church at Wytheville, VA, Capt. Charles H. Keffer. He predeceased her, and his obituary mentioned 5 children. Her obituary mentioned 6 children, 3 sons and 3 daughters.
