MRS. ELIZABETH BUNDRANT HARRELL EAKIN'S ESTATE

Mrs. Anita V. Eakin, 501 Sunhaven Drive, San Antonio, TX 78239 sent "records I have been gathering for some time on a Bondurant family, whose name has evolved into Bundrant out here in Texas.

I am not a Bundrant, but became interested in the group when I found that three members had married into the Eakin family. And, while searching the Bell Co., TX, courthouse for Eakin records I found the probate of Elizabeth (Bundrant) Harrell Eakin's estate. I was fascinated that one record could tell so much about a family! Sometimes it is better not to have a will!

Elizabeth (Bundrant) Harrell married my husband's great uncle, Samuel D. Eakin, 8 Sept. 1881, Coryell Co., TX. It was her second marriage, and she was his fifth wife.

I hope these records will add another chapter to the Bondurant family history," she concluded.

May 15, 1912 - Case #953 - EAKIN, ELIZABETH, dec'd, DANIEL L. BUNDRANT, Administrator.

Elizabeth Eakin, who died 23 March 1912, left as heirs: one sister, and the children and grandchildren of four brothers and two sisters, who are numerous and live in various parts of the State and Union.

Mrs. Nancy Bradley, being the only sister living and very old, now 77 years, cannot act as administratrix, and Daniel L. Bundrant is the applicant for administrator, by John B. Durrett, his attorney. Petition dated May 15, 1912.

Letters of administration were issued at the June Term of Court 1912, and Bond was \$9,000.00. Securities were T.S. (X his mark) Tippitt, W.H. Stoval, G.W. Cole, Jr.

The decedent owned a lot in Brookhaven, some land, and other assets (not copied).

Page 490, Sketch of SAMUEL D. EAKIN, b. Oct. 19, 1820 "9 days after his family got off" the ship from Ireland, to David Eakin and his wife Mary Macintire, both natives of Ireland. By 1826 this family had settled in Jasper Co., Mississippi where Samuel D. Eakins married Lucy Jane Phillips on Nov. 2, 1844. Lucy was born Feb. 2, 1827. Samuel served in Company C, 9th MS Cavalry, C.S.A. After the conflict the family moved to Coryell Co., TX where Lucy Jane d. Sept. 13, 1868, leaving 10 children, all born in MS.

Samuel D. Eakin died in Bell Co., TX in 1906, and was buried beside his first wife Lucy Jane in the old Eakin Cemetery at Cowhouse Creek. When Lake Belton was created, their graves were moved and are now in Resthaven Cemetery.

Book 5, p. 15 - William Alexander Eakin to Miss L[ucy] N[aoimi] Bundrant. Licensed 9-27-1892, married the same day by J.M. Seward. License returned 1-18-1893. He was the son of Samuel D. Eakin and his first wife Lucy Jane Phillips. Lucy Naomi was the dau. of Daniel G. Bundrant or Bondurant and his 2nd wife Mary S. (Walker?)

Index to War of 18912 Pension Files, Vols. A-F, transcribed by Virgil D. White, 1989.

Page 285: JOHN BUNDRANT, LUCY (GILLEY) 2nd wife. WC-14713. Married Apr. 21 1816 in Henry Co., VA. John d. 6-30-1850 in Lawrence Co., TN, and Lucy 9-9-1882 in Bell Co., TX.

John served in Ragsdale's Virginia Militia, lived in Lauderdale Co., AL [TN?], and Warren Co., TN. John's first wife was TABITHA BAYS, who d. April 22, 1813.

1880 census of Warren Co., TN:

"The first marriage of Daniel G. Bundrant to Mary J. ? [took place]. They appear in the 1870 census with the one child MARGARET. She later appears as MARGARET WARDEN in the final accounting of the estate of Elizabeth Bundrant Harrell Eakin as an heir.

The maiden name of Daniel's 2nd wife Mary S. [unknown]. Married probably in Warren Co., TN, since Lucy Bundrant stated in her application for a widow's pension, War of 1812, that she came to Warren Co., TN in 1871, where she resided with her son D.G. Bundrant.

I received very little response from the County Clerk of Fayette Co., TX, when I tried to find some records on this family, since it was the first place that I found them in the state [of TX]. I can see why, since the [sur]name was entered as BUNDRANT and POUNDRANT, etc.

Why Elizabeth Bundrant Harrell Eakin always put down her birthplace as IL [I don't know]? There is no indication in any of the records that the family was ever in that state.

Where Nancy P. Bundrant and W.H. Bradley paused long enough in AR to have the daughter, Josephine, age 10 in 1870 born; I have no further information on her."

Depositions given before A.C. Goff, J.P. of Warren Co., TN, by WILLIAM GILLEY and JEREMIAH J. VANHOOSER, both citizens of Cannon Co., TN, residing near Short Mountain, "we became acquainted with John Bundrant and his wife Lucy [Gilley] Bundrant since the year 1826-when they moved to Warren Co., TN from the state of NC." John died in the year 1850.

In her Confederate Widow's Pension application, Mary S. Bundrant stated that her husband's middle name was Daniel Gilla or Gillie Bundrant. Apparently this was taken from his mother Lucy's maiden name of Gilley.
